## **Additional School Accommodation**

The Department has formally approved a grant for the provision of additional accommodation for our school. The grant will fund an SEN suite and ancillary accommodation along with a number of other classrooms also. The approval of the grant is just one of many steps before the additional accommodation will be in place. The whole project involving building design, Department approval, planning permission, construction and much more will take a number of years to complete.

#### **School Tours**

In addition to a language exchange, three school tours abroad have been approved by the Board for 2023/2024. The tours will take students to Cologne, Germany and Paris, France for language and culture experiences, and a musical festival in Lucca, Italy

### Meeting of Boards of Six Sister Protestant Schools

At the end of November 2023, the Board of Ashton School met with the boards of five sister comprehensive school in Dublin, Wicklow and Donegal to collaborate and share experience. It was considered a very valuable experience.

#### Hall of Fame Award 2023/2024

It is planned that past student and actor Éanna Hardwicke will receive the Ashton School Hall of Fame award on Wednesday, 21<sup>st</sup> February. On the day Mr Hardwicke will also meet with fifth and sixth year students for Q & A sessions. #### Compass

Good progress has been made on adopting Compass, the school's new online database management system. Parents are encouraged to use the Compass app as the simplest and easiest way to explain absences.

#### **One-to-one Devices**

Students enrolled in first year 2024/2025 will use one-to-one devices. A meeting for parents will be scheduled in April and will be followed by the opening of the online shop.
